




WINE, BEER, DRINKS







	<p>Miss Terre Muscadet (B,N,ve) <i>Domaine de La Sénéchalière, Melon de Bourgogne, 2016, Muscadet, Loire, France, 12%</i> A Muscadet, but not quite as you know it, this wine is bright, vibrant, creamy and elegant. Aged on its lees for 9 months and coming from vines ranging from 60 to 80 years old, it is fruity, rich and intense. Sensational.</p>				44
	<p>Sancerre (O,ve) <i>Sylvain Bailly, Sauvignon Blanc, 2016, Loire, France, 12.5%</i> Ever the picture of style and sophistication, fresh green fruits meet high minerality to create this timeless classic. This husband and wife team have created perfect equilibrium in the eastern Loire Valley.</p>				46
	<p>Nanclares Albariño (ve) <i>Alberto Nanclares, Albariño, 2017, Rias Baixas, Galicia, 13%</i> A stand-out version of a Galician classic, this Albariño is made from 60 year-old vines with only low quantities produced, creating an ultra-pure expression: saline, fresh, precise and clean. Sunny sea air in a glass.</p>				46

<p>Trenzado (ve,volcanic) <i>Suertes del Marqués, Listán Blanco, 2017, Tenerife, 12.5%</i>  Herbaceous and creamy, with notes of sourdough toast and sesame, along with green fruits, stem and pith, this is a stand-out wine that erupts on impact. A Farmyard favourite that has to be tried.</p>	49
<p>Robola Unfiltered (ve) <i>Sclavus, Robola, 2017, Kefalonia, Greece, 12.5%</i> A lively and wild mineral-rich wine that exudes salty sea and sunny skies. Fruity, chalky and citrusy, with layers of character and a boisterousness that would give Captain Corelli a run for his mandolin.</p>	49
<p>Vale da Capucha Gouveio Branco (B,N,ve) <i>Pedro Marques, Arinto, Gouveio, Fernão Pires, Lisboa, Portugal, 13.5%</i> Grown on chalky soils packed with sea shell fossils, this wine bursts with minerality and salinity. Creamy and rich but bright and super-clean, it's a breath of sea air.</p>	50
<p>Tripoz Bourgogne Blanc (B,N,ve) <i>Céline et Laurent Tripoz, Chardonnay, 2017, Macon-Loché, Burgundy, 13%</i> Classic yet contemporary, this superb Bourgogne Blanc is made with minimal intervention but maximum care. Searingly fresh, super creamy, clean and classy with plenty of punch. A Chardonnay lover's biodynamic booty call.</p>	51
<p>Tillingham Qvevri White (N,ve) <i>Pinot Blanc, Chardonnay, 2018, East Sussex, UK, 12%</i> A blend of three whites, all made in Georgian-style qvevri. Half Pinot Blanc, whole-bunch pressed and aged for four months, the other half two separate qvevri of Chardonnay; one with skin contact, the other without. The result is a rich and robust wine with creaminess, umami and toasted nuts.</p>	56
<p>Selves Blanc (N,ve) <i>Domaine Nicolas Carmarans, Chenin Blanc, 2015, Aveyron, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 11.8%</i> Gorgeous grapes from a Parisian wine bar owner who decided to make the wine he wanted to drink. Elegant but robust, it bursts with flavours of melon and tropical fruit, notes of smoke and sexy, salty minerality.</p>	56

ORANGE & SKIN CONTACT

Baglio Bianco (B,N,ve) *Baglio, Catarratto, 2018, Sicily, Italy, 11%*

Embrace island life with this light skin contact wine from sunny Sicily. Cloudy, robust, saline, herbal and aromatic with citrus notes to boot. Refreshing but complex, you could shuck a few bottles.

El Carro Amphora (B,N,ve) *Bodegas Vinessens, Moscatel, 2018, Alicante, Spain, 13.5%*
Made in clay amphora, this medium-bodied and gloriously golden wine comes with floral and herb aromas of orange blossom, honey and toffee. Enjoy a saline bite, gentle tannins and a long elegant finish.

Tillingham Endgrain (N,ve) *Ortega, Chardonnay, Schönburger, Bacchus, 2017, East Sussex, England, 10.5%*

English orange wine with the tempo turned up. A canny blend aged partly in steel and partly oak, with food-stomping, skin contact, whole bunch pressing and absolutely no filtration or sulphur. Stone fruits, spice, umami and joy.

Christian Binner Si Rose (B,N,ve) *Christian Binner, Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer, 2016-7, Alsace, France, 14%*

A blend of Pinot Gris and Gewurtz, and a 50-50 blend of two years' vintages, the name of this mad-cap and deliciously tannic wine from the legend that is Christian Binner references both its rosé colour and (more darkly) cirrhosis of the liver. No sulphites, no filtering. Nothing added, nothing taken away.

Vacceos Tempranillo Rosado (ve)

Cuatro Rayas, Tempranillo, 2017, Rueda, Spain, 13.5%

Smooth and vibrant with cherry and strawberry flavours. Deep in hue and flavour and just a little bit wild at heart.

L'apostrophe Rosé de Provence (b,n, ve) *Domaine Les Terre Promises, Grenache / Carignan / Cinsault, 2017, Provence, France, 13.5%*

An elegant Provencal blend made from 25-year-old vines. Expect flavours of ripe peach, apricot, and red raspberry along with orange blossom, spice and a little effervescence.

Tillingham Rosé (b,n,ve) *Rondo / Orion / Madeleine Angevine, 2018, Peasmarsh, East Sussex, England, 10.5%*

Butterscotch, honeycomb and baked strawberries are the playful flavours in this grown-up pink juice made down the road. Fruity and flirty but with an alluring edge of bitterness. chris sexton plumber hastings

Gran Cerdo (N,ve) *Gonzalo Grijalba, Tempranillo, 2017, Rioja, Spain, 13.5%*
Feed your inner anarchist with these smooth and earthy grapes dedicated to the Greedy Pig Bankers that refused their support during the last recession.



Cuvée des Galets (BIB,B,N,ve) *Vignerons D'Estezargues, Grenache, Syrah, Carignan, 2016, Rhone, France, 14%*
Violets, herbs and aromatic red fruits mingle in this fun and friendly red made with minimal intervention and lots of love. Being in a box, it's good for the planet, too.

Primeros Pasos (ve) *Elisio, Monastrell, 2017, Alicante, Spain, 13.5%*
Rich, full-bodied and meaty with black fruit flavours and a hit of tannin, this is a robust wine that's at its best matched with red meats and rich dishes. If you like Cabernet Sauvignon, give this a go.

Soplo (ve) *Rafael Cambra, Garnacha, 2015, Valencia, Spain, 13.5%*
From cherries through to plums with an aromatic wet-leaves finish, this is a woodland walk in a glass. One for lovers of hedgehogs and summer's end. Glorious.

Les Trois Fontaines (B,N,ve) *Plaimont, Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon / Tannat, 2016, Côtes de Gascogne, France, 12%*
Smooth and rich with deep red fruit flavours, this is a Merlot blend that's full of the grape's characteristic easy-drinking fruitiness but with added liveliness and energy. Gorgeous grapes with a gorgeous price tag!

Ink (B,N,ve) *Judith Beck, Zweigelt / St Laurent, 2016, Burgenland, Austria, 12.5%*
Ink by colour, ink by name - ripe fruit, spice and summer berries fizz and explode in this medium-bodied but full-flavoured wine from the legend that is Judith Beck.

An excellent low-intervention Left Bank Bordeaux, and fantastic value in a region where bargains are few and far between.</p>		41

<p>Diamond Fields English Pinot Noir (B,N,ve) <i>Davenport, Pinot Noir, 2017, Rotherfield, East Sussex, England, 12%</i></p> <p>This punchy Pinot boasts a remarkably big body for an English red, with ripe cherry flavours giving way to a long finish. It has been made as naturally as possible, with no filtration or fining. A winner.</p>		46

Joiseph Roter Faden (N,ve) *Joiseph, Pinot Noir / Blaufränkisch / Zweigelt, Weinland, Austria, 11.5%*

An interesting blend of Pinot, Blaufränkisch and Zweigelt, this lively and enlivening wine pulls together crushed raspberries, eucalyptus and citrus zest in one intoxicating but easy drinking medley - a fine example of why Austrian reds are having a much-deserved moment.

Hellen (N,B,ve) *Progetto Calcarius, Nero di Troia, Puglia, Italy, 11.5%*

Created out of the shared passion of two Italian natural winemakers, this Puglian beauty made using spontaneous alcoholic fermentation without temperature control is grassy, herbaceous and a little wacky on the nose, but with excellent balance, mouthfeel and acidity to match. An excellent and endearing number.

Pompois (B,N,ve) *Nicolas Réau, Cabernet Franc, 2015, Anjou, Loire 12%*

A true reflection of the terroir it grows in, this complex Cab Franc is juicy and farmy yet smooth, with a long tannin finish. For lovers of Loire who want something to really get their teeth into. What a winner.

Arbois Jura Ploussard (B,N,ve) *Domaine de La Renardière, Ploussard, 2016, Arbois-Pupillin, Jura, France, 12.5%*

Ripe strawberries, wet leaves and earthy flavours abound in this light and natural red Jura that is energising and exciting with plenty of acidity. Like strawberry fields in a thunderstorm, it's a walk on the wild side through untamed forest flavours and bubbling berries.

Philippe Livera Gevrey-Chambertin Burgundy *Domaine Philippe Livera, Pinot Noir, 2015, Gevrey-Chambertin, Burgundy, France 13%*

Powerful yet delicate, this exceptional Pinot Noir is full of ripe raspberry flavours with a robust backbone and long lingering finish. Bright, light with a deep sensual earthiness balanced with an elegance arguably only the French can possess. A Burgundian beauty. Absolutely Fucking Gorgeous!



Aromatic, funky, dry and cloudy - a naturally made Italian beauty to give the French pétillant's a run for their money.

Clos Lapeyre, Gros Manseng, 2018, Jurançon, France, 12.5%

Honeysuckle, pear and ripe apricot abound in this luscious, golden dessert wine. Its unctuous sweetness is balanced by good acidity, making it honey sweet but not sickly.

Moscatel Dorado Sherry (ve)

Bodegas Cesar Florido, Muscat, NV, Jerez, Spain, 17.5%

A Farmyard favourite, this sticky sweet sherry spends two years in chestnut barrels which gives it a lovely nutty flavour, along with hints of orange blossom and caramel. A deliciously different way to end a meal.
